TARIFF STRUCTURE

Tariffs refer to the cost for services charged by the service provider. In order to determine the tariff structure for the Guyana Power and Light Inc, the Government of Guyana in granting a licence to the company stipulates the mechanisms and formulae for calculating of such tariff.

GPL is subject to a tariff review on a yearly basis and it may elect to apply to the Commission for an increase or decrease of such tariff. This is based on whether the company has made a profit which is significant to its allowable profit, therefore, it will decrease rates or if incurred a loss for the year, they will be required to increase rates.

From 2016, onwards, the Company has elected not to effect any tariff increases despite its losses for each ensuing year.

These rates offered from the Guyana Power Light Inc. reflects a reduction of 5% on fixed charges and a 15% fuel rebate, giving an overall reduction in tariff of 20% in 2016.
